Course Overview

This course teaches students about human rights and responsibilities in both the UK and worldwide. It is a written-based subject focused on the lives we lead.

GCSE Citizenship covers four key themes:

- 🏆 **Theme A:** Living together in the UK.
- 🏆 **Theme B:** Democracy at work in the UK.
- 🏆 **Theme C:** Law and justice.
- 🏆 **Theme D:** Power and influence.

Towards the end of the course, students complete their own Citizenship Action project (Theme E) putting what they have learned into practice.
