Dear Parent/Carer,

Breakfast Club will open from Tuesday 8th September 2020, from 7.30 a.m. to 8.00 a.m. Students will only be allowed into the canteen if they are purchasing breakfast, it **will not be an area for social gatherings** due to the coronavirus restrictions. Year groups will have their own designated tables to prevent the mixing of year group bubbles. At 8.00 a.m., Reception will shut and no further students will be allowed onsite. At 8.15 a.m., all student entrance points will open and students can come onsite and go straight to their bubble areas.

The catering team have requested students come to the counter to choose their breakfast (students will be required to wear masks when doing this). This will then be deducted manually from the student's account at the till points.

The breakfast on offer is outlined below:

Havering Catering Services provide a 'kick start' breakfast for PP students; one food item and one drink for £1.

There will be one member of staff and one member of SLT in the canteen during breakfast service to supervise the students.

A reminder that Year 10 and Year 11 students will order their food and collect during breaktime; Year 11 will collect from the canteen and Year 10 from the hall. Year 7 will have an earlier lunch in the canteen. Year 8 and Year 9 students will collect their lunch during lunchtime; Year 8 from the hall and Year 9 from the canteen.

Havering Catering Services are currently working on getting the online app for ordering food ready for the start of term. Information will be sent out shortly on how to pre-order food so that break and lunch run smoothly. Unfortunately, there has been a delay across all Havering secondary schools using this system. Students will still have the option of a hot or cold meal, this can be purchased in their designated lunch area and will be later removed from their account. Please can you make sure if you child is purchasing food from the canteen that their account is in credit.
