Alongside this update, I have also sent out a letter from the DfE offering specific advice around Covid-19.

As you will no doubt have heard, a number of schools locally have had a student or member of staff, who has tested positive for Covid-19. At the present time, we have luckily had no cases at Brittons but this may change in the future and we want to make sure we are all fully prepared and understand the procedures to follow. The advice from the Department of Education about what actions should be taken is becoming clearer and we remain confident that we are taking all the necessary steps to keep everyone safe.

If your son or daughter is tested positive for Covid-19, please isolate the entire household and inform us immediately on:

07912 379506 (all other times including weekends)

The second number will be checked outside of school hours and at weekends but must only be used for positive Covid-19 cases. Please leave a message on the voicemail. It is essential that you notify us as soon as possible after your child receives a positive test result as we need to take immediate action to make sure the rest of the school community are kept safe. Early notification from you will enable us to put in the appropriate measures in place quickly so that they have the biggest possible impact.
