Firstly, I would like to thank you for all your support during this turbulent time of the coronavirus pandemic. Our staff are working really hard to keep all students safe and present in school.


The Academy has a precise COVID-19 risk assessment. Outlined in this risk assessment is that windows and doors in classrooms should be open to keep the rooms well ventilated.
