Dear Parent / Carer

Re: Year 11 arrangements – Friday 13th May 2022

I hope that this letter finds you well.

I am writing to make you aware that the last timetabled day for Year 11 students here at the Brittons Academy will be Friday 13th May; you will of course appreciate, having received your son/daughter's exam timetable, that the GCSE examinations begin on Monday 16th May. Students will be on Study Leave from Monday 16th May but must be in school for each of their schedule exams.

The schedule of the school day for **Friday 13th May** is:

- 830am: Students will register in Form rooms.
- 850am-950am: (Period 1) Students attend lessons as normal.
- 950am-1050am: (Period 2) Students will be registered in their Science lessons. Sporting activities will take place on the field, shirt signings etc – **students will be supervised by teaching staff and the year team; they are not permitted to venture to other parts of the school.**
- 1050am-1120am: Break.
- 1120am-1225pm: Celebration Assembly.

Students will be dismissed from assembly at approximately 1230pm. Upon their dismissal, they are to leave the premises and ensure that they act in a manner that shows respect to the local community.

Students are able to wear non-uniform and will be required to make a £1.00 donation; this will go towards the Year 11 Prom. It is also very important for all students to be aware that Friday 13th May is a normal school day for all other year groups; other lessons are not to be disrupted in any way.

Some departments will be running intervention sessions during the exam season; this information will be forwarded to you once the schedule has been finalised. **It is also important for you to be aware that final GCSE examination takes place on Thursday 23rd June – all Year 11 students will be involved in this exam.** The GCSE results day will take place on **Thursday 25th August** – specific details regarding the arrangements will follow in due course.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support this year and wish your son/daughter every success in their upcoming GCSE examinations and in their future careers.
