Dear Families,

Re: Trip to Thorpe Park – Wednesday 27th March, 2024

On Wednesday 27th March, we have organised a reward trip to Thorpe Park. All students are invited; all they need to have is good attendance, a good attitude to learning and positive behaviour across the academy as indicated by their achievement points.

The criteria of 95% attendance or better and an attitude to learning of 3.1 or better has been set. Students with ongoing medical issues who have provided medical evidence will be exempt from the attendance criteria. We are really hopeful that all of our students meet these targets and are able to attend our trip.

Students will register at 7.30 a.m. for an 8.00 a.m. departure. Coming back, students will register at 3.00 p.m. for a 3.30 p.m. departure from Thorpe Park and we aim to be back at The Brittons Academy between 5.00 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. Students will be allowed to leave from school to go home as soon as we arrive back, please let your child's year team know if you would like us to keep them at school until you collect them.

Students should wear comfortable clothes and shoes/trainers. Some of the rides are wet ones, so they may wish to bring a waterproof jacket or a change of clothes. Students can either bring a packed lunch or buy food and drinks at the park.

The cost is **£32** for the coach and entrance to the theme park. If you would like your child to attend the trip, please add a minimum payment of **£1.50** via Scopay, our online payment system, as soon as possible. The remaining balance may be paid in instalments at times to suit you with the final balance due by **Friday 16th February 2024**.

Many students enjoyed the rewards trip last time we organised this event and we hope that your child is able to appreciate a day out with their friends to celebrate their success at the academy. If your child does not wish to attend, a normal academy day will be running for the students who did not meet the criteria or would prefer not to go.

If you have any questions, or would like to discuss a payment plan, please contact your child's Head of Year or Support and Guidance Manager as we do not want any child to be disadvantaged.
